

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular Oconee County Council Meeting was held October 19, 1982 at 3:00 P.M. in Council Chambers with all members present.

Members of the press Present: Dave Givens - Anderson Independent, Glen Gannaway - Seneca Journal & Dick Mangrum - WSNW Radio.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Williams.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 to adopt the minutes of the October 5, 1982 meeting as printed.

Ms. Bonnie Moses & Ms. Faye Lowry of the Election Commission gave a report to Council. They attended a State Board Meeting in April, they have also been to all the high schools, Tri County Tec, Roses Shopping Center, Pratt Reid and the Libraries to register people so they may be able to vote in the November election. There is a total of 31,262 white persons in Oconee County eligible to vote and 17,736 are registered. There is a total of 3,060 black persons in Oconee eligible to vote and 1,487 are registered.

Mr. Crain suggested that Ms. Moses make a list of needed supplies and equipment and turn it in to him so that he could refer it to committee.

Mr. Al Christo of Mt. Pleasant, S. C. requested a Palm Reader's License. Mr. Brandt made a motion that this request be denied with the understanding that he could come before Council again if he became a resident of Oconee County. This motion was seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0.

Dr. Earle made a motion that Resolution 82-8, "Inducement of Revenue Bonds for J & J Display Co." be adopted and signed upon legal review and approval. This motion was seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0.

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Mr. Butts made a motion that upon receipt of an investor's letter, Ordinance 82-12, "Industrial Revenue Bonds for J & J Display Co." in the amount of \$1,000,000 be adopted in title only on first reading. This motion was seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0.

Dr. Earle made a motion that Ordinance 82-11, "Water Treatment Referendum" be tabled until the legal questions surrounding this matter have been resolved. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Williams made a motion that Oconee County again administer the LIHEAP Program, it is basically the same program as was administered last year with each qualified applicant receiving around \$90.00. This motion was seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Harper presented the attached agreement between Oconee County and the City of Seneca to Council, Council deemed it would be wise to meet with Seneca City Council before making any decision.

Dr. Earle made a motion that Mr. Talley Grant be appointed to the Health & Sanitation Commission for a term of four years with his term expiring December 31, 1985. This motion was seconded by Mr. Brandt, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Brandt made a motion that the County accept from Mr. Backman Glymph a lot and a building on Hwy. 59 and it be used for the fire department and other community activities. Also there is an elderly gentleman who has a mobile home on the property and he wanted Council to agree to let this man stay there because he does look after the property. This motion was seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0.

Mr. Brandt made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 82-9, "Inducement of Revenue Bonds for Duke Power Co." be adopted.

Mr. Brandt made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 82-13, "Industrial Revenue Bonds for Duke Power Co." in the amount of \$130,000,000 be adopted in title only on first reading.


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Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Emergency Preparedness obtain bids for a new pontoon boat, new trailer and new motor.

It was decided that since the next regularly scheduled Council Meeting was on a holiday, it would be held on Monday, November 1, 1982 at 7:00 P.M.

At 4:50 P.M. Mr. Brandt made a motion that Council go into Executive Session, this motion was seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0.

Council did not go back into open session.
