

MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular Oconee County Council Meeting was held January 3, 1984 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present except Mr. Brandt.

Although all the members of the local press had been sent an agenda of the meeting only one member - Mark Davis of the Seneca Journal was present.

Press

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Williams.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Brandt absent) to adopt the minutes of the December 20, 1983 meeting as printed.

Minutes

First on the agenda was a public hearing to receive public comments concerning granting an easement over .628 acres of county property adjacent to County Roadway TU 5 and a public hearing to determine if County Roadway TU 5 should be abandoned with the understanding that a portion of the roadway shall be improved and the remainder of the roadway rerouted and that construction shall be in accordance with County Ordinance 82-14.

Public hearing

The only person present with any comments was Mr. Corky Moss who has purchased some property adjacent to County Roadway TU 5 and plans to develop it.

After considerable discussion concerning the twenty-four hour, twenty-five year flood pool and the fact that Ordinance 82-14 states anything specifically not spelled out in Ordinance 82-14 shall be in accordance with state guidelines which calls for a roadway to be built three feet above the twenty-four hour, twenty-five year flood pool Mr. Moss asked that Council wait until he checked his elevation figures before taking any action.

Mr. Crain presented the attached review of roadwork for the 1983 calendar year to Council.

Roadwork report

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Brandt absent) that the attached transfers (no new monies) be approved.

Transfers

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Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Brandt absent) that the attached application for federal assistance which is a matching grant in the amount of \$11,066 be adopted for the purchase of airpacs for Rural Fire.

Council agreed by mutual consent to sell twenty-five to thirty head of the county's cattle by sealed bids and the proceeds derived thereby to be used to purchase fertilizer for pasture. Bids will be opened February 7, 1984 and Oconee County reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

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Council agreed to advertise for a Public Hearing for the proposed use of revenue sharing funds to be held February 7, 1984 at 7:00 PM for the purpose of receiving public proposals or suggestions concerning the allocation of available revenue sharing funds in the 1983-84 Supplemental Appropriation Ordinance.


