MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, December 6, 1988 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media. Present for the meeting were members of Cadet Troop 359 and members of Seneca High School's governmental class.

The invocation was given by Mr. Harper.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the November 15, 1988 meeting be adopted as printed.

At the request of Sheriff Earl Holcombe, Dr Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that \$7,603 confiscated drug funds be placed in line item number 10 004 00150 00870, capital expenditures vehicles, to be used toward the purchase of a 1989 four wheel Chevrolet Suburban. The total cost of the vehicle is \$16,447.84.

Also at the request of Sheriff Earl Holcombe, Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that \$917.76 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 004 00150 00840, capital expenditures equipment, for furniture for computer equipment.

Mr. John McIntosh addressed Council concerning business education for citizens of Oconee County. Mr. McIntosh stated the problems of business education are not unique to this area, but neither is there a national solution, he felt a long range educational plan is needed. He also suggested a committee consisting of three (3) members of Council including the Supervisor-Chairman, three (3) members of the School Board including the Superintendent of Education and someone from the planning commission be formed to address the problems and develop long range educational plans.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that Council go on record supporting the group.

Mr. Robert Winchester, Sewer Commission Director, addressed Council concerning 7-Q-10. Mr. Winchester informed Council that 7-Q-10 is going to drastically effect the operations of their facility at Coneross Creek. Basically this is a term assigned to the flow of the creek and it will govern the amount of discharge that can be contributed from the Coneross treatment facility. It will also determine the types of industry that can be attracted to Oconee County that will be on the sewer system, metal type industries will be the ones most effected.

Mr. Winchester further informed Council that in June he received a memo which stated the 7-Q-10 number had been adjusted to 30.5 million gallons, in August it was adjusted to 16.4 million gallons and September it was reduced to 13.23 million gallons.

Mr. Winchester stated the Sewer Commission was appealing this 7-Q-10 flow assigned to Coneross Creek. They also have a verbal commitment from USGS for share costing a gauging station for Coneross Creek. Mr. Winchester plans to get this commitment in writing.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Council go on record supporting the Sewer Commission and assisting with legal fees.

Mr. Ray Smith, Airport Director, informed Council that the present underground fuel tanks at the airport will have to be removed due to the fact they are twenty five (25) years old. He further informed Council they could be removed before December 22, 1988 and EPA would not have to be present, but after that date EPA would have to be present to monitor the removal and the ground around the tanks.

After discussion, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that these tanks be removed before December 22, 1988 and the Purchasing Department secure bids for underground tanks and above ground tanks to replace the existing tanks.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that \$13,702.50 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 014 00150 00840, capital expenditures, for the purchase of seventy five (75) refurbished votomatics at a cost of \$170 each plus shipping.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that county purchasing procedures be waived and \$7,548.93 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 026 00350 26351 for the purchase of anti-freeze for the cooling tower at the Walhalla Library.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that Ralph Stone be awarded the bid for fencing for the E-911 signs at a cost of \$1,844.17.
