Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Council go into executive session for a legal briefing.


Executive Session

When open session resumed, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that Council accept the arbitration settlement with Interstate & Allis-Chalmers on behalf of the Sewer Commission for \$110,600 and Mr. Leo Hill be authorized to do whatever is necessary to effect the settlement.
