## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, June 16, 1992 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

The meeting was called to order by Super-visor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

At the request of Mr. Jerry Dyar, Veterans Affairs Officer, Mr. Donald made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the Veterans Van be located at the Law Enforcement Center.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Donald, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers for the Motor Pool be adopted.

Also at the request of Mr. Lee Davis, Motor Pool Foreman, Mr. Stone made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that the bid process be waived and the parts to repair the brakes for the Fiat Allis 263B for the CCS Department be purchased from Van Lott.
