The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, September 1, 1998 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members present. Mr. Brad Norton, Acting County Attorney, was also present.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Orr who welcomed the guests and media.

Invocation:

The invocation was given by Mr. Timms.

Minutes:

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that the minutes of the August 18, 1998 meeting be adopted as printed.

Ordinance 98-9

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that Ordinance 98-9, "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN OCONEE COUNTY AND MILLIKEN COMPANY WHEREBY CERTAIN ASSETS USED IN THE MANUFACTURING PROCESS WILL BE LEASED TO MILLIKEN & COMPANY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO" be adopted on second reading.

Fee in Lieu of Taxes:

Mrs. Lombard, Finance Director, gave each Council Member the attached estimate of the funds the county would collect from fee-in-lieu-of-taxes rather than the collection of taxes from the same industries.

ATAX Grant:

Upon request of Mr. Herb Jones, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hall, approved 5 – 0 that the attached ATAX Grant in the amount of \$11,000 to the Blue Ridge Arts Council be adopted.

Airport (Fuel Truck):

Upon recommendation of Mr. Marion Lyles, Airport Manager, & Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mr. Thomas, approved 5 – 0 that the bid for a fuel truck for the airport be awarded to Bosserman Aviation who was low bid at \$36,200. (See attached bid sheet)

Ordinance 98-8:

Mr. Thomas also informed Council there was a charge for using the auditorium at Seneca High School, Mr. Hamilton volunteered to negotiate this charge on behalf of the county.

Roads Update:

To Mr. Timms' inquiry, Mr. Orr informed Council that we are now in the process of completing a "C" Fund request for work that has been completed on county roadways.

Apple Festival:

Mr. Timms reminded Council Members of the Apple Festival Luncheon that is scheduled September 11, 1998.

Possible Park Areas:

Mr. Timms informed Council that Duke Power has lake access acreage which they are interested in leasing as park areas. If the county is interested in leasing any of this acreage, we will have to let them know by December 31, 1998. The county will also have to submit a plan for the park area to Duke Power Company.

Executive Session:

Mr. Timms made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that Council go into executive session at the end of the meeting to discuss pending litigation.

Planning Meet:

Mr. Hall made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Hughes, approved 5 – 0 that an informational session be scheduled between Oconee County Planning Commission & Pickens County Planning Commission.



III. NARRATIVE PROJECT DESCRIPTION

B. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

The purpose of this project is to renovate, caulk, paint repair and gnerall refurbish the exterior of a historical church building now in use as an art gallery by the Blue Ridge Art Council of Oconee County

This building was built in the late 1800's as a church structure untilit was purchased by the Blue Ridge Art group in the 1950's. It is listed on the National Register of Historic places and is recognized by the South Carolina Department of Archives and History as a significant structure in Oconee County.

It is located on South Second Street in Seneca not far from the Lunney Museum and within walking distance from the center of Seneca and the newly restored Ram Cat Alley. This central location in the middle of Seneca and it's proximity to other attractions make it an asset to the heritage of Oconee County. The gallery is open on a daily basis and and art in various mediums is exhibited by local and visiting artists as well as by students from several of the local schools. A visito registor is maintained in the gallery which indicates a wide variety of people and interests. A volunteer or staff member is always available to guide visitors through the exhibits.

The building itself is in general good repair, but does need significant exterior refurbishing and psinting. This work must be done with extreme care following the guidelines of the Historical Commisions in order to maintain the integrity and historical value of the building. The project requires that the old paint and damaged wood be removed with extreme care because of the age of the structure. The current front door and front steps and porch are must be replaced due to age as well as and to provide a safe and secure entry and to conform to the historic nature of the rest of the building.

Enclosed are photographs of some of the damaged areas which must be addressed. The front entrance modifications cannot be accurately estimated until the actual refurbishing is completed.

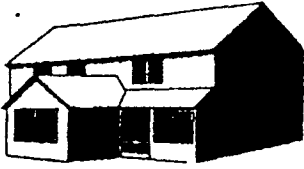
Of the three (3) estimates submitted, Mr. Dotson's includes a partial estimate of the door replacement, and due to the fact that Mr. Dotson is in the process of doing some new construction on the adjoining building, his estimate is my choice.

C. WHO WILL IT BENEFIT

The beneficiaries of this project will be the residents of Oconee County and the surrounding counties and the MANY visitors and tourists to whom we can demonstrate South Carolina, and particularly, Oconee County heritage.

Dear Ms. McSwain:

It was a pleasure meeting you last Wednesday. I am very pleased that the ATAX commission voted to grant the Blue Ridge Art Council the funds to refurbish the gallery building in Seneca.

As requested, I reviewed the visitors register at the gallery to determine the number of visitors from out of the state or country who would qualify as tourists. My figures are approximate because some of our visitors did not specify their original home base, but for the period of June 1996 through June 1998, there were approximately 2300 (twenty three hundred) visitors to our gallery. Of these there were about 225 (two hundred and twenty five) who came from other states or countries or were from distant parts of South Carolina and would have required overnight stays in our county.

I am also enclosing the missing estimate of materials for the church painting. These are a bit more than I originally thought, but I believe that we can get the job done for the requested amount of funds.

I am aware of the reporting requirements and will execute these as required as the project progresses.

Again, thank you and your commission for considering and granting our request.


