The Oconce County Conservation Bank Board met in Council Chambers, 415 South Pine Street, Walhalla, SC with all Members present [except Mr.'s Harwell, Hill & Lee] and Elizabeth Hulse, staff haison.

Call to Order:

Mr. Aircy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. noting that a quorum was present.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Land made a motion, seconded by Mr. Prater, approved 4 = 0 to approve the minutes from the March 1, 2012 meeting as presented.

Discussion & Possible Adoption of Criteria Scoring Form

Mr. Airey reviewed for those present the status of this form along with the three approved at the last meeting. The Board discussed both this form and the process in general. It was suggested that a third section potentially be added noting verification of the information provided. Lengthy discussion followed.

Mr. Land made a motion, seconded by Mr. Nations, approved 4 – 0 to adopt the OCCB Criteria . Scoring Form as presented.

Old Business:

OCCB Bank Account Follow-up 501[3]c Status Update

Mr. Airey noted that he had discussed both the establishment of a bank account and the Boards need to establish itself as a 501[3]c with a colleague, Mr. Cary Hall, Esq., who noted that as the Board was created by ordinance; there was no need to establish a separate 501[3]c as any donations would be considered charitable donations according to state law. Mr. Airey noted that he also verified this information with the County Treasurer, Mr. Greg Nowell.

Discussion followed regarding electing a Treasurer. Four current members of the Board do not serve as officers. Mr. Airey asked the staff haison to contact the four to identify both their desire to and willingness to potentially serve as Treasurer. The role of the Treasurer in part would be on a monthly basis to reconcile the bank account [once established] and to report monthly to the Board regarding account activity.

Mr. Airey also noted that Mr. Nowell stated that the county routinely uses Community First Bank in Walhalla for their accounts. The Board had not objection to establishing an account at this bank. Mr. Airey noted that establishment of a bank account will require the following information. Discussion followed with Board actions listed after each issue:

"Trial Run" / Test Application & Criteria Sheet

Mr. Land volunteered to meet with staff at the Soil & Water Conservation Office to obtain their assistance in compiling this list and to report back to the Board at a future meeting.
