Shea and Beth,

There is a good probability that I won't be able to make it to the next meeting Tuesday due to work-related travel.

However, from previous discussions, I have the following to report:

We've talked about the possibility of being able to receive proceeds from wetland mitigation transactions between developers and the Army Corps of Engineers. From what I've been able to gather, it sounds like the ability to receive mitigation funds is very competitive and limited. The ACOE does have a list of eligible mitigation banks, but funds from wetlands typically have to go to a bank that deals primarily with wetland preservation and/or restoration. Moreover, most of the time the mitigation proceeds have to go toward a project in the same county. Since we aren't really in the business of acquiring land or performing restorations, this may be a dead end. I am playing phone tag with someone from the ACOE Charleston District which has jurisdiction for all of South Carolina; if I talk with him and get additional or different information, I'll send that to you.

Again, sorry I won't be there Tuesday.
