BALLOT Process

- Commission will need to elect either the County Attorney or the staff liaison to act as the "teller" who will compile the ballots and report results at the meeting.
- Each Commission Member casts one vote (votes for one of the nominees on the ballot) for each round of balloting; they may write in other candidate(s) not nominated. The votes are anonymous, but each Commission Member should sign his or her name to the ballot upon completion. The teller will receive the folded ballots.
- 3. To be elected a candidate must receive a majority vote.
- If no candidate receives a majority, Commission will be required to vote again.
 - No candidate is removed from the ballot.

- No candidate may be forced to withdraw his or her nomination, but may voluntarily do so.
- 5. If one candidate receives a majority, that candidate is elected
- If three candidates receive a majority vote, no one is elected and the process would have to start over.

Once the election process begins no motions are proper aside from privilege motions (adjourn, recess, raise a question of privilege, raise a point of order, follow agenda).
