RESOLUTION 2009-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL PRICE ON CERTAIN PRODUCT OF THE OCONEE COUNTY ROCK QUARRY.**

**WHEREAS**, Oconee County, South Carolina (the "County"), a body politic and corporate and a political subdivision of the State of South Carolina, operates a rock quarry (the "Rock Quarry") as a function of County government, for the convenience of its citizens and businesses and to reduce the operational costs of County government; and,

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, and because of fluctuating demand, the Rock Quarry will have an excess of one or more rock products; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Oconee County Council (the "County Council"), to keep Rock Quarry prices competitive and to free up space at the Rock Quarry, may, from time to time, offer special pricing on Rock Quarry product that is in excess supply; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Rock Quarry currently has an oversupply of screenings, a rock product useful in making concrete or concrete pipe, or as pipe cover fill material and other uses, and Oconee County Council desires to reduce that supply by offering special pricing on screenings from the Rock Quarry for the time being.

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby resolved, by Oconee County Council, in meeting duly assembled, on behalf of all Oconee citizens, that:

1. Screenings produced by the Oconee County Rock Quarry will be sold for \$2.00 per ton (as opposed to the usual \$5.75 per ton), until such time as the Manager of the Rock Quarry signifies to the County Administrator that screenings are no longer in long supply at the Rock Quarry. At such time the price of screenings at the Rock Quarry will revert to the normal price of \$5.75 per ton, automatically, without further action by County Council.
2. Should any portion of this Resolution be deemed unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such determination should not affect the remaining terms and provisions of this Resolution, all of which are hereby deemed separable.
3. All orders and resolutions in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict only, repealed and rescinded.

**THIS RESOLUTION WILL TAKE EFFECT** immediately upon enactment.
