

GETTING TAX MAP INFORMATION FROM THE OCONEE COUNTY WEBSITE

(Turn off any **pop-up blockers** on your computer that may prevent access to this site.)

From the Oconee County home page, click on

"Property Information, Maps, & GIS Downloads"



Select "Interactive Map 3.3"

Click on the  tool bar to open the query box.

IF YOU ALREADY KNOW THE TEN-DIGIT TAX MAP PARCEL NUMBER:

If you have the ten digit tax map parcel number, then click on "Parcels" in the drop-down box in the window next to **Layer:** in the open query box to select that layer;


Double click on "TMS_Number" in the list below the **layer:** window to start a query in the query box. (This layer name will appear in the query box at the bottom of the window.)

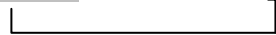
Click once on the "=" character in the character selection section.,

Click once in the query box after the '=' sign.

Enter the ten-digit number enclosed in single quotes (apostrophe) with dashes and no spaces, (' ### - ## - ## - #### ')

Occasionally the last set of digits may be 4 numbers


Click on the "Execute" () button at the bottom of the query box.




Anytime you see this message, just click on "OK" and continue



The selected parcel that corresponds to the map number will be highlighted in blue.

To display other layers in the map, such as the contour lines, the background photo, or others, click on the "Map Contents" () bar for the drop down menu, then click the layer names to turn layers on or off.

For detailed information, such as acreage, parcel owner, etc., click on the

"i" tool () in the toolbar, then click in an *open area* within the selected parcel (do this to avoid selecting other features such as roads, contours, or labels) and the "Identify Results" box will appear. Scroll side to side or up and down with the scroll bars at the side and the bottom of the window to view parcel information.

TO SEARCH BY ADDRESS:

Searching by address is not currently an option but should be available in the future.

TO SEARCH BY ROAD NAME:

In the "Attribute Query" box, Select either the "Road (with names)" or the "Roads" layer, then double-click on "FULLNAME", single click on "=", Click on the "Get Unique Values" button to get a listing of all roads in the database.

Scroll through the listed roads and select the desired road name, Double-click on the road name to enter the name into the query box after the '=' sign Click the "Execute" button.

A "Selection Results" box will appear with all the available road segments with that road name. Wait for the background image to appear and the first road segment for the selected road will be displayed in blue. The *selection results* box can be dragged out of the way or closed by clicking on the X in the top right-hand corner.

USING THE MAP TOOLS:

The map tool bar has buttons that can be enabled by clicking on them once. The commonly used buttons are:

Zoom in or out, Pan the image, Identify feature, Measure, Clear selection, or Print



PRINTING MAPS:

Click on the print icon, type a title if desired, select the print orientation and size.

Then click on "View Map".

A new window will appear with your map displayed.

(Make sure there are no pop-up blockers enabled on your computer.)

Select File Print.
