## MINUTES OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 1,1979

The regular meeting of County Council was opened by Chairman Phinney with the invocation by Mr. Crain. All Members of Council were present.

Minutes of the April 17th meeting were approved as furnished. Motion by Mr. Crain second by Mr. Frady.

Ordinance 79-5 "Mobile Home Ordinance" was adopted on Second Reading-Motion by Mr. Ables, Second by Dr. Earle. The vote 5 For and 0 Against.

Ordinance 79-6 "Supplemental Budget Ordinance" was adopted on First Reading. Motion for adoption by Mr. Ables, second by Mr. Crain. The vote 5 For and 0 Against.

Since the funds in the Sheriff's budget for telephone is exhausted, Mrs. Jennings moved to approve payment of the telephone bills for this department on a month by month basis after they are reviewed. Mr. Frady seconded the motion which carried.

Mrs. Jennings announced the CCS Commission would meet May 3rd at 7 P.M.

Mr. Frady stated bids are being received for items in the 79-80 budget for delivery after July 1.

Mr. Crain told Council the new rock crusher would be in operation within a week. He further stated he was well pleased with the installation and with the cooperation of Interstate Equipment Company who sold and installed the facility. They are including a winch for big rock at no charge.

Council denied the Town of Walhalla's request to haul stone from Liberty for the Chicopee ball field. It was agreed to ask the Town to wait until the new crusher is operating and they can buy it from the County and haul with their own trucks.

Mr. Phinney announced, as information, that the Moser house and lot adjacent to the County Motor Pool is for sale and thought it could be purchased for approximately \$40,000. No action was taken.

After discussing Council's meeting hours it was decided to continue meeting at the same hour.

Council adjourned at 8 P.M. for a budget committee meeting.
