MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, March 5, 1985 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all members present.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Butts.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the February 19, 1985 meeting be adopted as printed.

Minutes

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5-0 that Ordinance 85-3, "Industrial Revenue Bonds for Nacan" in the amount of not exceeding \$500,000 be adopted on first reading.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 85-9, "Resolution & Petition to State Budget & Control Board Concerning Nacan" be adopted on first and final reading.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 85-10, "Resolution Authorizing Petition to State Budget & Control Board Concerning the Issuance of Industrial Revenue Bonds for Piedmont Quilting" not to exceed \$1,500,000 be adopted on first and final reading.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5-0 to adopt Resolution 85-11, "Resolution of Approval to State Budget & Control Board Concerning Piedmont Quilting" on first and final reading.

After considerable discussion Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that bills of the Magistrate's Office outstanding as of March 5, 1985 for printing by the Westminster News be authorized for payment.

Mr. John Floyd of the State Aeronautics Commission informed Council there were three problems that needed to be taken care of in order to open runway seven at the Oconee Airport, there are some power poles that need to be relocated, some pecan trees that need cutting and a transormer that is twelve (12) feet too high. Mr. Floyd said he would reduce these to writing and include a statement that when these were taken care of the runway could be opened, Mr. Crain should be receiving this letter this week.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the Summer Youth Food Program be discontinued as the program was greatly abused last year.

Mr. Dyar, Chairman of the Roads & Transportation Committee reported to Council that after an on site inspection that this committee determined that an extension of WA 179 does not qualify for acceptance into the county road system as requested by Mr. Eugene Butts; that county maintenance of PU 46 (Tugaloo River Road) should continue to terminate near a big rock and that maintenance not be extended from that point to Brasstown Creek as requested by Mr. Corky Moss; and that a road in the Courtney area off SC 130 near Fox Drive In does not qualify for acceptance into the county system as requested by Mr. Derrill Keese.

Road report

Dr. Earle, Chairman of the Personnel & Intergovernmental Committee reported the committee would make a recommendation to Council to allow removal of members from commissions for reasons other than not attending meetings. He also reported the committee would make a recommendation to Council concerning a commission to oversee Lunney Museum.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached arts contract be approved.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Rueben Mackey be reappointed to a four year term on the Sewer Commission representing the Westminster District with his term to expire January 1, 1988.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - O that Mr. Frank Clary be appointed to the Sewer Commission to complete the unexpired term of Mr. Richard Phillips with his term to expire January 1, 1986.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that \$150 be taken from contingency to pay for service contract on copier for Board of Registration.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the attached transfers (no new monies) be approved.

A Meeting of the Building & Grounds Committee was set March 11, 1985 at 6:00 PM to discuss the woodland at the county farm and some requests for additional office space at the court house.

Mr. Crain referred to the Law Enforcement Committee a request from the City of Seneca that Mrs. Becky Gerrard, Seneca Magistrate, be appointed as Associate City Recorder.

Council reviewed the attached list of employees, commission members, etc. being covered by Tort Insurance but no changes were requested.

The Budget & Finance Committee set a meeting March 11, 1985 at 5:00 PM to discuss Supplemental Appropriations.

There will be a joint meeting of the Roads & Transportation Committee & the Purchasing Committee March 19, 1985 at 2:00 PM to discuss bids for plant mix, etc.

Council also agreed to meet March 12, 1985 at 7:00 PM at the Keowee Visitor's Center with Tri County Tec to discuss their budget.
