## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, October 20, 1987 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Seneca Journal, Keowee Courier, Greenville News, Anderson Independent, The Oconee Leader, WGOG Radio, WSNW Radio, WCCP Radio, WLOS TV & WYFF TV.

Members of the press present: Sue Nolan - Seneca Journal, Dave Partenheimer - WSNW Radio, Dick Mangrum - WGOG Radio & Randall Holcombe - Greenville News.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Harper.

Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the October 6, 1987 meeting be adopted as printed.

First on the agenda was a public hearing to receive written and/or oral comments concerning Council authorizing revenue bonds for Log Cabin Mfg. Co. in the amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

Mr. Brandt, County Attorney, stated a buyer for the bonds had already been obtained.

Mr. Ron Kopczyk, a citizen, asked if there would be any strong odor coming from the plant or how much of this money would be used for pollution control.

Mr. Brandt stated one half of the funds would be used for expansion and one half of the funds would be used for operating expenses.

Next, The Honorable Sally Smith, Oconee County Clerk of Court, on behalf of other elected officials and Department Heads at the courthouse presented Dr. Earle, County Council Member Dr. Julius Earle with a resolution expressing the appreciation of the citizens of Oconee County and the Department Heads for the help and support he has given them in his years of service to the county.

Mr. Walt Purcell, Emergency Preparedness Director, presented Council with proposed expenditures of the FNF Funds received from Duke Power Company each year. The total amount in the grant account is \$27,800, Mr. Butts made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the attached proposed expenditures be approved.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5-0 that Mr. Jack Kell's resignation from the Rural Fire Commission be accepted.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. James D. Cater be appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Kell which expires January 1, 1990.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5-0 that \$43.62 be taken from contingency and placed in line item number 10 054 00110 05405 to upgrade that position from a Medium Equipment Operator to a Heavy Equipment Operator II for twenty one (21) pay periods.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Butts, approved 5 - 0 that the attached lease for the Seneca Health Clinic be approved.

In response to Mr. Ron Kopczky's question concerning pollution control at Log Cabin, Mr. Ted Napier, associated with the company stated there would be a drying tunnel so the varnish would dry quickly, there would be no fabrics involved and the plant would be up to date environmentally. There would not be a lot of noise as the building will be insulated.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4-1 (Mr. Harper voting against) that the recommendation of the Chairman of the Registration Board be accepted on the paint and roof for the new building being built for that office. The siding will be California Rustic and the roof will be red mingled with gray.
