MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, October 4, 1988 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members and the County Attorney present.

All other persons who have asked to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Williams.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that the minutes of the September 20, 1988 meeting be adopted as printed.

Mr. Donald Towe of the Home Builders Association presented to Council the attached resolution from the Home Builders Association requesting Council to adopt the "Standard Building Code" of the Southern Building Code in Oconee County.

Mr. Crain stated this would be assigned to committee which he would appoint in the near future.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Oconee County enter into a contract with Business Records Corporation for the re-creation of records in the Clerk of Court's Office. Business Records Corporation is a sole source for this service. (See attachment)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5-0 that the low bid for sign posts, blanks and materials for the E-911 project be approved as follows:

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5-0 that Stone Castle Auction Sales be awarded the bid for auctioneering services for the county auction be to be held Saturday, October 15, 1988 at 10:00 AM. (See attached bid sheet)

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5-0 that the CCS Department be granted permission to hire a Green Thumb Worker at no cost to the county.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5-0 that the Assessor's Office and the Animal Shelter be allowed to hire JTPA Workers at no cost to the county.

Dr. Earle made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved approved 5-0 that the National Guard be given a grant in the amount of 1,025 for the purchase of a lawnmower.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 88-22, "A Resolution Honoring the Seneca High School Baseball Team, Known as the "Lindsay Oil Company" Team on Winning the Palmetto Minor Championship" be approved on first and final reading.

After discussing the termination dates of the members of the Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission, Dr. Earle asked the Council Clerk to check with the members to determine if they would continue to serve on that commission.

Mr. Williams, Chairman of the Building & Grounds Committee, asked that the Purchasing Agent check the costs of moving the phones at the landfills and purchasing two (2) portable toilets to be used at the landfills.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Dr. Earle, approved 5 - 0 that the attached request from the Health Department to utilize additional space in the building in which the Seneca Health Clinic is occupied be assigned to the Building & Grounds Committee for a recommendation at the next Council Meeting.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 5 - 0 that the bid for paving the parking lot at the Mt. Rest Fire Department parking lot be awarded to Blue Ridge Paving Company who was low bid at \$3,708 for six hundred, eighteen (618) square yards

The Building & Grounds Committee scheduled a meeting Thursday, October 13, 1988 at 4:00 PM to review and study the office needs of the Seneca Health Clinic.

Mr. Brandt, County Attorney, briefed Council on the court case involving Greenbriar Subdivision versus Oconee County. At this time the court has ruled in favor of Oconee County, however, they have until October 10, 1988 to appeal further.
