MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, January 17, 1989 at 3:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members except Dr. Earle present.

All other persons who have asked to be notified of meetings were also notified by mail.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Dyar.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4 - 0 (Dr. Earle absent) that the minutes of the January 3, 1989 meeting be adopted as printed.

At the réquest of Mr. Robert Gaillard, Planning Commission Director, Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 0 (Dr. Earle absent) that Mr. Gaillard proceed with application for a grant to the South Carolina Budget & Control Board in the amount of \$13,500 for enlargement capacity of the Perkins Creek Station.

Mr. Ralph Nix, Chairman of the Health & Sanitation Commission and Mr. Gary Shaw, CCS Director, addressed Council regarding the landfills charging \$11.25 per cubic yard for materials disposed of at the landfills that have to be approved by DHEC and require special handling. After discussion, Mr. Strickland, Chairman of the Law Enforcement, Health, Safety, & Welfare Committee deferred this to be the last item discussed at the Council Meeting.

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 3 - 0 (Mr. Harper out of room, Dr. Earle absent) that \$500 belonging to RACES Keowee Toxoway Amateur Club which had been left with Emergency Preparedness by George Allgood upon his resignation from RACES be returned to RACES as it had been deposited in general funds.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dyar, approved 4 - 0 (Dr. Earle absent) that approximately fifteen (15) hours per week overtime be approved for the personnel of the Auditor's Office due to reassessment. (See attached request)

Mr. Dyar made a motion, seconded by Mr. Stone, approved 4-0 (Dr. Earle absent) that the bid of Hall Signs be accepted for sign blanks for the E 911 program. The total cost of the blanks is \$36,411.90 which will come from "C" funds.
