## MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, July 8, 1993 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers with all Council Members present. Mr. Cain, County Attorney was also present.

This meeting had to rescheduled from July 6, 1993 to July 8, 1993 due to being advertised incorrectly.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the regular meeting held June 15, 1993 be adopted as printed.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the minutes of the special meeting held June 22, 1993 be adopted as printed.

Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0 that the bid for chemical spraying for the roads be awarded to Green Pastures, Inc. (See attached bid sheet)

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams that Ordinance 93-5, "An Ordinance to Provide for the Sale of Surplus Yard Waste, Mulch and Like Products by Oconee County and to Prescribe the Manner of Such Sales and the Payment and Accounting Therefor" be adopted on third and final reading.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that Ordinance 93-5 be amended as delineated on the attached copy.

Mrs. Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that Resolution 93-16, "A Resolution Prescribing the Cost Schedule for Surplus Mulch, Yard Waste & Other Related Products by Oconee County" be adopted on first and final reading.

Upon recommendation of Mr. Michael Willimon, Aeronautics Commission Chairman, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper, approved 5 - 0 that the county apply for a grant in the amount of \$470,709 which is a 5% state funding match and a 5% local funding match for a total amount of \$523,010 for the aircraft apron expansion.

Mrs. Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Dwight Littleton be appointed the Emergency Preparedness Commission to replace Mr. William Squires who resigned. Mr. Littleton's term will commence immediately and expire December 31, 1995.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that Mr. Frank Lanford and Mr. Fred Hamilton be reappointed to the Private Industry Council with terms commencing July 1, 1993 and expiring June 30, 1996.

When open session resumed, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 5 - 0 that the county purchase parcels 9, 3, 2, 6, 7, 4 & 5 as delineated by Mr. Hawk, Right of Way Technician, for the construction of manned convenience sites at a total cost of \$68,500.

Mr. Crain also informed Council that he had also received the appraisal for the Battle Clinic in Seneca which was appraised for \$120,000.

Rosa Clark

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Harper that the county proceed with applying for a grant for the purchase of this building for the Rosa Clark Clinic.

Mr. Orr stated that he wanted to go on record as opposing this project because he was afraid that at some future date the county would have to fund the operation of this project.

The motion to commit to this project was adopted 4 - 1 (Mr. Orr voting against).

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Burrell, approved 4 - 1 (Mr. Orr voting against) that the option for the purchase of this building be \$3,500.

The Roads & Transportation Committee scheduled a meeting Tuesday, July 13, 1993 at 8:30 AM for the purpose of discussing the road priority formula and three (3) bridges that need to be replaced.
