MINUTES, EMERGENCY MEETING, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor-Chairman Crain.

Call to Order

Mr. Crain informed Council that due to the heavy rains from tropical storm Beryl, Oconee County has seven (7) roads that are closed and numerous roads that are heavily damaged.

Meeting

Mr. Dennis Bauknight & Mr. Ed Gephardt of the Soil & Water Conservation addressed Council regarding federal assistance on these roadways. Soil & Water Grant

After discussion, Mr. Harper made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Strickland absent) that the County apply for a United States Department of Agriculture Soil Conservation Grant in the amount of \$350,000 to repair these roadways. This is a 75-25 match grant and the County will use service in kind and funds from the road line item in the budget, if necessary, as its match portion.

Council also agreed to meet with the Sewer Commission, Monday, August 29, 1994 at 8:30 pm to discuss the purchase of a sludge drying machine.
