MINUTES, OCONEE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The regular meeting of the Oconee County Council was held Tuesday, July 16, 1996 at 3:00 pm in Council Chambers with all Council Members (Mr. Strickland came in at 3:10 pm) and the County Attorney present.

Members of the press notified (by mail): Journal/Tribune, Keowee Courier, Westminster News, Anderson Independent, Greenville News, WGOG Radio, WBFM Radio, WCCP Radio, WYFF TV & WLOS TV.

Members of the press present: Ashton Hester Keowee Courier, Greg Oliver - Journal/Tribune & Terry Cregar - Anderson Independent.

The meeting was called to order by Super-visor-Chairman Crain who welcomed the guests and media.

The invocation was given by Mr. Orr.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Strickland not present) that the minutes of the regular meeting held June 18, 1996 be adopted as printed.

Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Orr, approved 3 - 0 (Mr. Strickland not present, Ms. Burrell abstaining) that the minutes of the special meeting held July 5, 1996 be adopted as printed.

Mr. Ken Johns, Mayor, City of Walhalla, addressed Council regarding the Sheriff's Department overseeing dispatch for Walhalla on the second shift. Mr. Johns informed Council they had asked for this service since 1989 and they did not feel they, as county citizens, were getting what they paid for.

Mr. Johns further informed Council he did not feel the convenience center in the Ebenezer Community was in a good location, the City of Walhalla had plenty of room and they would be willing to have one inside the city limits.

Mr. Steve Pruitt, Chief Deputy, responded to Mr. Johns' request by informing Council if the Sheriff's Department had received the city's request before the budgets were submitted they could have asked for additional dispatchers to handle second shift calls for Walhalla. The Sheriff's Department is presently handling dispatch for the city on the third shift as well as checking tags and licenses for them.

Mr. Pruitt also informed Council that it might be possible for the Sheriff's Department to handle dispatch on the second shift for the City of Walhalla after the new dispatchers are trained.

Mr. Cain, County Attorney, informed Council that the Sheriff is a duly elected constitutional officer and they have no jurisdiction to dictate what he will or will not do

The request of Mrs. Mona Towe, Delinquent Tax Collector to re-advertise for a Part Time Account Clerk I position was denied upon motion by Ms. Burrell, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 5 - 0.

Upon request of Mr. Steve Pruitt, Chief Deputy, and Mr. Buddy Hawk, 911 Coordinator, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman, Mr. Crain temporarily out of room) that a back up tape recorder for Communications be purchased using a portion of the \$.48 tariff that is charged to phone customers each month. The cost of the equipment is approximately \$25,000.

Mr. Steve Blackwell addressed Council regarding the site of the manned convenience center in the Ebenezer Community. Mr. Blackwell stated his concerns were:

- (1) Inappropriate location
- (2) Ineffectiveness of location
- (3) Ill sited, low usage will occur or there will be danger from adequate usage
- (4) There is no logic in the green boxes it replaces
- (5) The site is contrary to the recommendations of the leaders of Walhalla & West Union

Mr. Blackwell further recommended that construction be stopped, the situation be re-evaluated and the site be remediated.

Mr. Mike Evatt stated a site on Highway 188 would be a more ideal location.

After further discussion, Council informed them they had tried to secure several sites other than the one that was chosen, but they were unsuitable or unavailable.

At this time Supervisor-Chairman Crain had to leave the meeting and Vice Chairman Orr presided over the remainder of the meeting.

Upon recommendation of Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that the bid with Byerley & Payne, P.A. and Kirk S. Messick, P.A. for auditing services for fiscal year 1996-97 be renewed at a cost of \$24,245. (See attached letter)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Lee Davis, Motor Pool Foreman, & Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Director, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that the bid for wrecker service for the county be renewed for six (6) months until January 10, 1997 with Carter Wrecking Company. (See attachment)

Also upon recommendation of Mr. Davis & Ms. Dillard, Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that the bid for repairing the wrecked patrol car be awarded to Owens Automotive who was low bid at a cost of \$6,094. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Tommy Crumpton, Rock Crusher Director, Mr. Lee Davis, Motor Pool Foreman, and Ms. Marianne Dillard, Purchasing Agent, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that the bid for repairing the 980C Cat Wheel Loader be awarded to Blanchard Machinery, Co. who was the only bid at a cost of \$120,202. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon recommendation of Mr. Jack Hirst, Solid Waste Director, Mr. Davis and Ms. Dillard, Mr. Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Strickland, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that the bid for replacing the track rails on the Fiat-Allis be awarded to Boggs Tractor Company, Inc. who was low bid at \$19,479. (See attached bid sheet)

Upon request of Mr. Hirst, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that \$63,000 be transferred from line item 016 049 00150 04932 into line item 016 049 00150 00840 for the purchase of nine (9) roll off containers, a fork lift and a tractor/mower for the Materials Recovery Facility with the understanding these funds will be replaced through the lease/purchase program.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that Mr. Buddy Hawk negotiate the cost of cover dirt to close the Seneca Landfill under Subtitle "D" regulations.

Mr. Hamilton made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that Resolution 96-34, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRST INTEREST PAYMENT DATE TO BE MARCH 1, 1997 WITH RESPECT TO THE \$2,800,000 OCONEE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 1996 HERETOFORE AUTHORIZED BY AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL ON JUNE 4, 1996 AND OTHER MATTERS WITH RESPECT THERETO" be adopted on first and final reading.

Mr. Hamilton informed Council that he had not been able to schedule a meeting with the property owners regarding a right-of-way on Deerwood Lane.

Mr. Hamilton further informed Council that Mr. Dirk Reis with the SC Appalachian Council of Governments had assured him the county was pursuing the right channels to get something done regarding the bridge on Radio Station Road. However, there is a long waiting list for such grants and it could be several years before that bridge could be corrected by grant.

Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Williams, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that Mr. Michael Bond be extended credit at the Rock Crusher as per Ordinance 91-10, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALE OF SURPLUS STONE, GRAVEL, AND LIKE PRODUCTS BY OCONEE COUNTY AND TO PRESCRIBE THE MANNER OF SUCH SALES AND THE PAYMENT AND ACCOUNTING THEREFOR, AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 78-8 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 79-12".

Upon recommendation of Mr. Buddy Hawk, Right -of-Way Technician, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that portions of the following roadways be abandoned back to the land owners:

Ms. Burrell made a motion, seconded by Mr. Hamilton, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that Resolutions 96-30 through 96-33 be adopted and the honorees be invited to the August 6, 1996 Council Meeting to be presented these resolutions.

Mr. Orr, Chairman, Roads & Transportation Committee, informed Council it was the recommendation of the committee that Mr. Hawk determine if Santee Drive qualifies for county maintenance as a non subdivision.

Further the committee is recommending that the county seek rights-of-ways on both sides of TU 104 to place a culvert to alleviate a water problem on that roadway.

Both these recommendations were adopted 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman).

Upon request of Mr. Kenneth F. Williams, County Auditor, and recommendation of Mr. Timothy M. Cain, County Attorney, Mr. Strickland made a motion, seconded by Ms. Burrell, approved 4 - 0 (Mr. Orr acting as Chairman) that \$790.08 be taken from contingency and placed in line item 010 021 00150 24304 to correct a billing error of twenty-eight (28) mills rather than the approved thirty (30) mills in taxes which should have been collected for the Town of Salem for the tax year ending December 31, 1995 contingent upon the county making no admission of liability and obtaining a release from the Town of Salem.

Mr. Cain also informed Council that the county owns a portion of what Mt. Nebo uses as a parking lot at the church, they are interested in purchasing this property, the church needs to have a plat made of the property, it is his opinion that the county does not need this property, however, the SC Department of Commerce, Division of Aeronautics and the

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
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

We have estimated the clay available at the Pruitt sites as follows:

Pruitt Site #1 (site with house): 60,600 yards
Pruitt Site #2 (site with trailor): 27,000 yards

We recommend that the County pursue obtaining this soil at a reasonable cost. These figures represent approximately half of the amount of clay needed to cap both the permitted and unpermitted areas at the Seneca Landfill, including the vertical expansion area (not including C&D area).

Please note that these figures are estimates and actual quantities may be considerably more or less. Actual quantities will not be known until the site is excavated during construction.
