Highlights of their presentation follow:

- Ash Tree Program
- Transitional Housing & Recovery Programs for men and women
 - O Phase I [Day 1-45]
 - O Phase II [Day 45-90]
 - O Next Steps [Day 90 and Beyond]
- Request for Oconee County to cover both utility [power & water] and building maintenance costs for the program.

Additionally, two citizens [Mr. Jay Winstep and Mr. Jonathan Murphy] gave addressed the Committee giving testimonials regarding the programs benefits in their and their families lives.
