Planning and Code Enforcement Update

Mr. James Coley, Oconee County Planning and Zoning Director, addressed the Committee utilizing a power point presentation entitled, "Planning, Zoning, and Code Enforcement 2022 Overview and Update" [copy in backup].

Mr. Coley addressed the following topics briefly to the Committee:
