


Operations

Lead: A lead is an inquiry that has the potential to become a new project or expansion. A lead is often responded to with specific information that aids in the site selection process


Project: A project is a lead that has visited Oconee County, or met with the Oconee Economic Alliance staff either in-person or virtually.

TWO ANNOUNCEMENTS



- Netherlands-based CurTec, a manufacturer of high performance packaging goods, announced they would establish a new manufacturing facility at Oconee Industry and Technology Park.
- The 34,000 square foot facility is expected to result in an anticipated capital investment of \$13 million and 32 new jobs. CurTec broke ground on the project in June



Impact Housing

- · Impact Housing Group an Atlanta-based manufacturer of modular homes announced and broke ground at Oconee Industry and Technology Park for their new 140,000 square foot manufacturing facility.
- The \$30 million project is expected create 215 new jobs.

 - ✓ Representatives shared their positive experiences with workforce, the business climate and quality of life in Oconee County.






Product Development

Golden Corner Commerce Park Site Grading

- Partnered with Oconee County, South Carolina Department of Commerce and SC Power Team to secure significant funding to clear, grade and make pad ready 42 acres at the Golden Corner Commerce Park.
- The project will allow OEA and SC Department of Commerce to better market the park to projects, as it expedites the time for building construction and when a business can become operational.
- The project will also positively transform the appearance and perception of the park. The project is expected to be completed in 4th Quarter 2023.

Seneca Rail Park

- Partnered with Oconee County and AT&T to secure funding to construct a gravel access road for the eastern portion of the Seneca Rail Park.
- The park has been somewhat difficult to traverse and the new access road will allow OEA to better show the property to projects.
- The work is expected to be completed in 3rd Quarter 2023.

Business Development Activity

New Inquiries, Leads and Projects

- 25 Inquiries of which 8 (32%) became Leads.
- 5 (63%) of the Leads converted to Projects.
- 1 Lead from 2022 became a Project.
- New Leads and Projects for 2023 represent the potential for:
 - √ \$548.9 million in new capital investment
 - √ 2,699 new jobs

Active OEA Leads and Projects (Includes Carryovers from 2022)

- 39 active Leads and Projects
- Active Leads and Projects represent a potential capital investment of over \$8.2 billion and 14,365 jobs.
