1. Call to Order

Ms. McPhail called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Ms. McPhail responded that a draft was in the process, and communication with the members of the Agriculture community has continued.

8. New Business

Mr. Anspach informed the Commission that staff is working on proposing amendments to the current Planning Commission rules for discussion and consideration.

Mr. Anspach also informed the Commission that staff was currently working on a potential amendment to the setback requirements for small lots in the County.

Mr. Anspach informed the Commission that the next Community Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, August 27, 6:00 p.m.


Mr. Anspach informed the Commission that the next Commission Meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 14, 6:00 p.m.
